There have been so many changes in our world over the past two years and the Democratic Republic of Congo is no exception. Like many other places, the schools in the Congo have been shut down and reopened, only to be shut down again. Many public schools have delayed their opening as teachers are re-




Opening day ceremonies at Mango Tree School are held in new chapel.

fusing to work without an increase in salary. With that said, we are so thankful that Congo for Christ (CCC) Mango Tree School (MTS) has opened its doors in October for the new school year with a total

of 263 students registered. Each school year, we see more children begin the year than are able to complete the school year. Many of these students are forced to drop out of school because their parents are unable to continue to pay the monthly fees. As you can imagine, this makes it very difficult to meet the expenses to run MTS. Mango Tree School continues to receive awards as one of the top primary schools in Uvira, and the children are also receiving Biblical training along with their educational studies. Global Outreach provides many scholarships and subsidizes the operating expenses as much as possible, but additional help is always needed. For only \$12 per month, a scholarship can be given to a child in need. A monthly gift of \$75 would help provide a salary for a teacher.

In addition to Mango Tree School, there are several other areas where CCC is requesting our help.

- \$3,700 new batteries and repairs to solar power
- \$3,000 solar power for new chapel
- \$2,200 generator
- \$3,500 computers, printer for MTS
- \$1,800 used clothing for community children
- \$ 750 first aid supplies for MTS children

Your gifts towards any of these expenses would be a big blessing to our friends in Congo.
