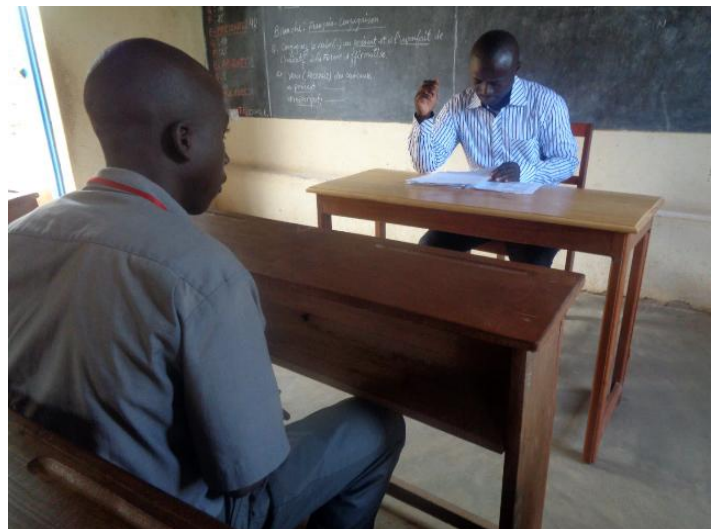

He hopes this knowledge will help them become independent and thriving students and citizens. Brother Etulo Asende has a secondary certificate in teaching and a university diploma specializing in French. He has 6 years of teaching experience and this is his second year teaching at MTS. Brother Etulo Asende teaches all the subjects in this class apart from English which is taught by a different teacher. He currently has 35 students in his classroom at MTS.

Brother Asende said that before he starts any lessons he begins his lesson with the word of God. He also emphasizes to students the power of forgiveness and the importance of loving God with all their heart, soul and mind and living that out daily. Another way students are being feed the word of God is through Saturday chapel. Every Saturday morning the school has a chapel service where pastor's from CCC teach the students and staff the Gospel of Jesus.
