New bunk beds have crowded the children's homes.

Last year, in an effort to improve the living conditions in the Fizi Children's Homes, we purchased bunk beds for the children. Unfortunately, the new beds did not all fit into the homes, and consequently some of the boys had to move into temporary quarters. We have been searching for a solution to this problem, and now a new dormitory is under construction. The girls will move into the new home when it is complete, and this will open up much needed space for the boys.



Foundation of the new girls home needed lots of large rocks.

Once the construction began, Pastor Fred told us that no trucks were available in Fizi and this was presenting a big problem in obtaining construction

materials. As you can see in the picture below, the church members did what was necessary to enable them to begin construction of the dormitory. They carried the large rocks on their heads to use for building the foundation. The construction is progressing well, and we expect the girls will be able to move into the new home in July.

Disciple Training School in Myanmar

The 8th Discipleship Training School, funded by Global Outreach in the past four years, came to a successful completion with the graduation ceremony on May 24th. This class of students represents eighteen different tribal groups. Seventy students were awarded completion certificates. Of these, six were newly appointed missionaries and an additional 34 are committed to working full time in various churches and villages.

Even though Pastor Richard was very ill and hospitalized for a portion of the three-month school, the eight hour a day, six days a week, teaching continued with the help of other church leaders. As Pastor Richard says, *“We are teaching about being Timothy.
