*Bethel Orphanage in Vietnam was established many years ago by *Li Su and her husband. Today, thirty children are being raised in this loving and Christ-centered home. They have had to relocate many times due to persecution. In 2020, they were able to rent a larger home which is much better for the children. They continue to experience some persecution and harassment in the new location, but *Li Su works hard to promote good relations with the government and neighbors. The new home also has a larger kitchen which they use not only to feed the children but to prepare food for the patients they visit in the hospital and other outreach ministries.

The older children had not been allowed to have jobs, but this has recently changed. Two of them are now employed at a Korean school and this income is a blessing. They were thrilled to be able to work after the pandemic.
