Over the past few months we have been reporting about the struggles and hardships our friends have been experiencing across the globe. While many challenges still exist, we thought you might appreciate knowing that the orphans at Congo for Christ (CCC) are doing well in spite of flooding, lockdowns, school closures, and rising food prices. The above picture was taken at the CCC annual anniversary celebration. They had a special meal and fun times celebrating the eight years of living and growing at CCC.

In the May newsletter, we shared the need for repairs at CCC due to the extreme flood damage. We were able to send \$5,150 for phase one of the repairs in June and a new drainage ditch is near completion. Phase two will involve the construction of another drainage channel which will protect walls in danger of crumbling from future flooding. The cost of completing phase two is \$10,590.

While we are working diligently to complete the drainage system, we have also learned of an urgent need to expand the septic tank. The current tank is completely full and is now leaking dirty sewage into the surrounding area and even on to neighboring property. This situation needs to be resolved as quickly as possible. The bathrooms and showers also need renovating. The cost for the new septic tank is \$3,267 and to repair the bathrooms will be an additional \$3,610.



Praise God for all the progress that continues at CCC. Also, we are thankful to share the good news of the safe arrival of a new daughter, Promise Salama to Daniel and his wife, Nehome.
