## Happy Children in Bangladesh



These 17 children are thankful to call Grace their new home.

Construction of Grace Children's Home started in November 2021 and now fourteen months later, it is home to seventeen precious children. Prior to moving into Grace, many of them mentioned they did not have enough food to eat on a daily basis. Several of them had attended school for a year or two while living with a relative but were not able to continue in school. All of the children are between five and nine years of age.

## Fizi Children's Home—DR Congo

It was on our first visit to Democratic Republic of Congo in November, 2010 that we became acquainted with Pastor Fred. At that time we were building Congo for Christ and working to establish a children's home on the property we had purchased in Uvira, DRC. We saw him again in 2016 when he served as one of the interpreters for us. We did not have the means to support his ministries at that time but we stayed in touch and did help him as funds became available.

In 2021 we learned that the Fizi Children's Home he had established had lost their sponsor and were unable to feed the orphans who lived there. They would go to different church members homes and get some food, then return home to the orphanage to sleep. In July 2021 we felt compelled to help them and accepted the responsibility to become the main source of sponsorship for the home. This added \$2,000 per month expense stretched our resources and we have not been able to provide much more than the basic food and hygiene supplies for the 33 children who live there. They have been so

thankful for the help we have provided and have not requested much additional help from us.

Shortly before Christmas we became aware of the need to provide new mattresses and blankets for the children. The beds they had been using were all broken and unsafe and so the children sleep on simple foam mattresses on the floor. The blankets were torn and ragged. We were able to provide new blankets for them for Christmas and they were thrilled. We have not been able to get the picture of the mattresses they are currently using out of our minds. We would love to provide them with new mattresses and one set of sheets for each child.

A new mattress costs \$65 and a set of sheets an additional \$15 which will be a total of \$2,640 for the 18 boys and 15 girls who live at Fizi Children's Home.
