outreach in the Tiruvannamalai area of the state of Tamil Nadu. The ninety-one pastors who attended want to work with Feed My People. They shared stories to explain how difficult it is to preach the gospel in Tamil Nadu. They are forbidden to preach or distribute Bibles in public places. He said it is their desire to reach all twenty-eight states in India with the gospel message. To facilitate this outreach, they are requesting \$300 to purchase a LED screen to take to villages and show the story of Jesus to people who cannot read and write.

In addition to caring for the children at Emmanuel orphanage and pastoring a church, Pastor Pham and Hong Suong take the opportunity to minister to hundreds of people during the Christmas season. They visit prisons, hospitals, leper villages, juvenile detention centers, as well as the local community children. They feed everyone, provide games and activities for the children and tell them about

Jesus. Many of those they reach have never heard about Jesus, and this is an ideal time to share God's love with them. We were able to send a donation to help with this year's outreach.

We have also learned that they are in the process of trying to secure property on which to build their own church and children's home. This would be a tremendous blessing as we have previously reported, they have had to move locations quite often due to harassment from neighbors and police.



Update from Congo for Christ Center in Uvira, Democratic Republic of Congo

Daniel has been doing a good job of keeping us updated about the latest news from CCC. We were happy to hear that the M23 rebels left the city of Uvira on January 17th. Unfortunately, as the city came under the control of the government forces and other militia groups, the unrest, violence, looting, and similar activities escalated rapidly. Shots were fired into the two homes where the CCC children are currently living. Seven bul-

lets were found in the houses and yards. Once again, God protected our friends, and none of the children or staff have been injured by the violence. Many of the children are traumatized and fearful, and the staff members pray with them and do all they can to comfort them. Food supplies remain scarce and expensive, and we are continuing to send as much additional funding to help as we are able to.
