Over the past few months we have shared many needs from our friends in several nations. We wanted to give you updates on some of these projects.

Myanmar: Agape Children's Home



Pastor Richard reported a very successful Mission Training School with 40 students in attendance. Many young people put their faith and trust in Jesus and are now spreading the good news in many villages. They are leading morning prayer and praise services, home church meetings and personal evangelism. Many others are now looking forward to a future training event. The graduation ceremony was very moving. As each student received their certificate, they read in their own dialect Isaiah 6:8, "Here am I, send me."



Goat project. We provided funds to purchase one goat for each family in the Kungshuh village. Pastor Richard said they had tears of joy as they taste of the goodness of God!

Other needs for Agape and Myanmar Missions:

\$8,000 to purchase adjoining land to provide room for expansion and agriculture projects to support Agape. \$200 per month for 10 new children to be added to home as they are hiding in the jungle to prevent being taken as soldiers by the military. Parents are begging for help. \$20 per child for fifty students for school uniforms and supplies.



India: Feed My People

Tailoring School: We were able to provide funds to purchase six sewing machines which will provide tailoring schools in two villages.



Valluru Village

We were also able to purchase a good plot of land for the new orphanage, church, and health clinic in Valluru village. We cannot begin construction until we have at least half of the \$37,000 needed for the building. This will provide a home for fifteen orphans and also shelter for homeless elderly.

News from our Friends Around the Globe

Bangladesh: New Orphanage and Ministry Training Center.



Pictured above is the ground floor of the new orphanage building currently under construction. The plan is for the bottom floor to house twenty five children, as well as the pastor's family. A kitchen and dining hall will also be located on the ground floor. The second floor will be used for worship services, ministry training, and various meetings. This is a big project that started in November 2021. Building supply costs have risen sharply since the construction started. When the ground floor is completed and the children and caregivers move in, they will need about \$2,500 per month for operating expenses. We are trusting God to supply this need.



Please pray about helping to provide for these children on a monthly basis. Pastor *Samuel wants to move the children in by the end of the year so they can begin school in January 2023.

DR Congo, Fizi Territory.



Pastor Fred shared the urgent need to help the family of a Pastor who recently passed away. Her name is Mapendo Wabiwa, and she has seven children. Since she has no income we asked if we could help her start a small business so she can provide for her young family. For \$400 we can provide her with a sewing machine and materials to begin a tailoring business. This will mean so much for this precious family.
